



SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

If you are enrolled in or participate in and contribute to the City 401(a) Retirement Savings Plan or the 457(b) Deferred Compensation Plan, your high school graduate could win \$2,500 for college!

Nationwide and the City of Baltimore's Retirement Savings Plan (RSP) and Deferred Compensation Plan (DCP) will award five college scholarships - each worth \$2,500 - to five high school graduating seniors whose parents or grandparents participate in the 401(a) Retirement Savings Plan and/or 457(b) Deferred Compensation Plan.

Eligibility Requirements



- Graduating high school seniors who are legal U.S. residents are eligible to apply
- Applicant's parent or grandparent must be enrolled in and contribute to the 401(a) Retirement Savings Plan or 457(b) Deferred Compensation Plan.
- RSP & DCP employees, RSP Board members and the immediate family members of both are not eligible to apply
