RESPONSE TO THE SPREAD OF
CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

In response to the Mayor's declaration of a State of Emergency effective 12:01 pm March 18, 2020, the City Union of Baltimore is taking the following actions to minimize the spread of the CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) while actively continuing operations here at CUB. The following actions are intended to minimize the spread of the virus and for the protection of all CUB bargaining unit members, staff, and the general public:

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

- In-person meetings with CUB Staff shall be temporarily discontinued, unless determined by Staff to be absolutely necessary under the circumstances.
- In the event of Discipline, Discharge, Grievances, and related meetings involving the foregoing, your LRS should be contacted directly by telephone and email to ensure timely filing, and as necessary, to make alternative arrangements for conducting such meetings and preserving time limits.
